



Refresher In-Service Emergency Vehicle Operation (EVO)

A one-day program designed for in-service officers. Students will train to the current MCOLES standards. The curriculum includes 3 hours of classroom instruction, and 4 hours of driving range training. The areas covered in the classroom and reinforced during practical exercises are:

- Vehicle dynamics
- Emergency driving
- Skid control

- Vehicle maintenance
- Defensive driving
- Civil/criminal liability

There will be a written examination as well as testing on the practical exercises. Final summary results of all test areas will be sent to the agency upon completion of training.

Please note: Classes will begin at the MCJTC. We recommend each student bring/wear weather-appropriate clothing, a hat, sunglasses/protective eyewear and sunscreen. Please bring one police vehicle (marked or unmarked car or SUV) for every 3 students.
